The city of Aarhus

Aarhus is quite unique. The city itself is vibrant and full of life. And encircling it is magnificent natural beauty with woods, lakes, and 20 kilometers of beach. The city is also known for its high concentration of students. One in seven inhabitants is a student at one of the city's 25 educational and research institutions. In total, there are more than 45,000 students in Aarhus.



In the heart of the city centre behind the cathedral lays the 'Latin Quarter', the oldest quarter of Aarhus. The Latin Quarter is the place where the new and the old meet. The beautiful old half-timbered houses and cobblestone streets provide a unique atmosphere all of their own, and the Latin Quarter is also one of the most trend-setting places in Aarhus, especially when it comes to the selection of specialty, fashion and design shops. Along the re-opened Aarhus river, the cafés lie side by side, and the electrifying buzz which is present here represents the very soul of Aarhus' city centre. For shoppers Aarhus has more than 1 kilometer of pedestrian streets with more than 150 shops. The pedestrian streets stretch from the Central Station all the way down to the main square by Aarhus Cathedral.









Aarhus boasts a rich and highly varied cultural life. In the city there are 22 concert and music venues, 16 museums and amusement parks, and more than 400 cafés and restaurants.

The cultural institutions below are partners for the 9th TeamGym ECh 2012 and offer all accredited persons a special deal on their entrance:

- <u>ARoS Aarhus art museum</u> 50% discount on entrance fee (featuring the city's new landmark, Your Rainbow Panorama, on the roof of the museum)
- <u>Den Gamle By (The Old Town)</u> –
 Entrance for only 80 DKK. If you are under 18 years entrance is free.
- <u>Tivoli Friheden amusement park</u> Free entrance

Getting to and from Aarhus

Getting to Aarhus is quick and easy no matter where you enter from. Frequent national and international train and bus lines and two international airports one hour's drive from Aarhus – Aarhus Airport and Billund Airport – all provide easy access to the city. LOC offers domestic transfer from the nearest airports, Aarhus Airport and Billund Airport, by busses.

- Transfer from Aarhus Airport to hotel in Aarhus: 30 EUR per person
- Transfer from Billund Airport to hotel in Aarhus: 40 EUR per person

Note: Transfer fee is forth and back, price in only for delegations staying at official event hotel in Aarhus.

Local transport in Aarhus during the event is included in the accommodation packages.







The competition Venue NRGi Arena

Aarhus' main sports complex – NRGi Park & Arena – is the venue for a large number of the major sports events held in the city, situated in a beautiful location at the edge of the Marselisborg woods, only two kilometers from the city centre. There are 4500 seats for spectators.
